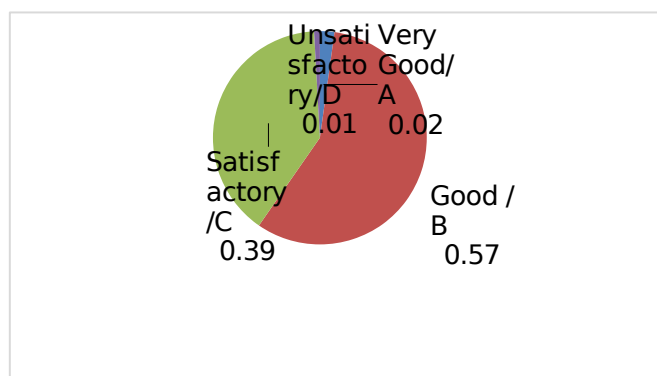

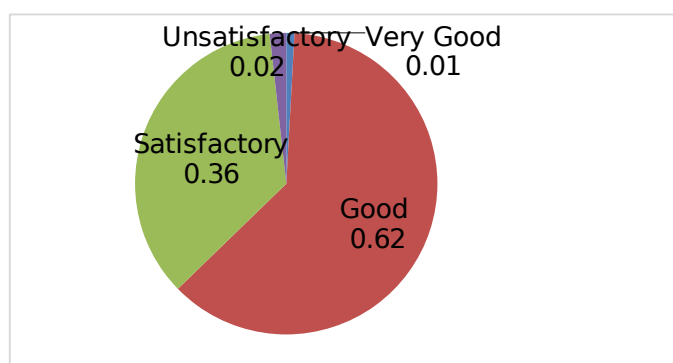

3. Sincerity/Commitment of the teacher-educators (in terms of preparedness and interest in taking classes)



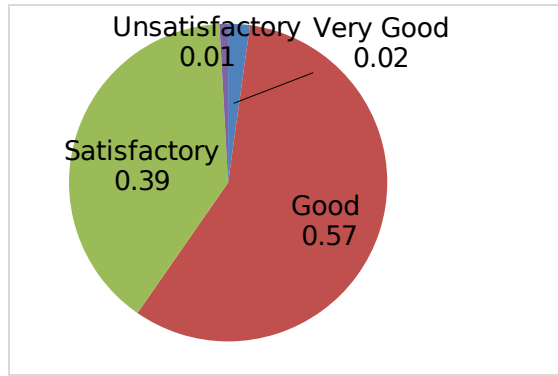
