

**IASE B.ED. ENTRANCE EXAMINATION
RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1) All candidates should enter the Examination Hall and take their seats 30 minutes before commencement of the Examination.
- 2) Candidates will not be allowed to enter the Examination Hall after commencement of the Examination.
- 3) No candidate will be allowed to leave the Examination Hall within one hour of the commencement of the Examination. Furthermore, no candidate will be allowed to re-enter the Examination Hall.
- 4) Candidates shall enter the examination hall only after producing their **Identity Card (Adhaar/ Voters ID/ PAN/ Driving License)** as it is required to produce the same if and when asked for.
- 5) Candidates are not allowed to carry any book or paper other than Identity Card.
- 6) Candidates are not allowed to carry mobile phone, smart watch, tablets, calculator or any other electronic device inside the Examination Hall.
- 7) Sharing of materials such as pen, pencil, eraser, ruler etc. is not permitted during the Examination.
- 8) Each Candidate shall write his/her Written Exam Serial Number to the space provided in the OMR sheet/ answer sheet & question paper supplied to the candidate.
- 9) A candidate having completed his OMR Sheet, answer booklet and question booklet must hand it over, even if blank, to an Invigilator before leaving the Examination Hall. The OMR sheet, answer booklet / question paper must on no account be left on the desk. No candidate will be allowed to remain in the Examination Hall after submission of papers.
- 10) No candidate shall leave the Examination Hall without submitting the OMR sheet, answer sheet and question booklet. However, a candidate may, with the special permission of the Invigilator, leave the Examination Hall temporarily, with a valid reason only, under the vigilance of a person to be deputed by the Centre Superintendent.

ANNEXURE II

- 11) A candidate shall not help or try to help any other candidate nor obtain or try to obtain any help from any other candidate or any other person. No candidate is permitted to speak to an Invigilator or on any matter with reference to any question or answer.
- 12) Candidates must not write any objectionable or improper remark in their Answer Booklet/ question paper or attempt, in any way, to render identification of the Answer Booklet difficult by giving false name or number or intentionally omitting mandatory information.
- 13) Candidates are cautioned against attempting to use any unfair means at the Examination. Any breach or attempted breach of the Examination Rules and Regulations will render them liable for immediate expulsion which will be final and unappeasable.
- 14) In the event of any misconduct by any candidate and any consequent action(s) taken thereof by the Centre Superintendent, the decision of the Centre Superintendent will be final and uncontested.
- 15) Candidates are advised to check their Examination Routine/Shift carefully before Examination(s).
